Recently, Ms. Parker was a member of the trial team responsible for the \$142 million civil RICO jury verdict against Pfizer for unlawfully marketing the drug Neurontin. Ms. Parker contributed to the certification of a nationwide RICO class of third party payors in the Zyprexa marketing litigation and the subsequent appellate briefing to the Second Circuit Court of Appeals. She also oversaw the implementation of the Vioxx third party payor settlement with Merck. Currently, Ms. Parker is involved in litigation regarding the drugs Neurontin and Actimmune, as well as artificial lumbar discs and smoke alarms.

Ms. Parker graduated cum laude from Dartmouth College and earned her J.D. at Boston College Law School. During law school, Ms. Parker was an oralist for the Phillip C.
